- The Welcome Home Reentry Program provides mentoring opportunities to interested participants who are currently incarcerated and returning to the community within one year. Everyone needs a second chance, and rebuilding a life after incarceration can be complex and confounding.
- The program matches volunteer Mentors with men and women seeking a path toward success. Volunteer Mentors and Mentees meet once a week for an hour over the course of a year.
- Our goal is to help prevent returning citizens from falling back to old ways that led to incarceration by
 assisting them in discovering and following a path to employment, stable housing and other supportive
 services.
- We do this by creating a support network centered around trained volunteer Mentors, and staff who work closely with Mentees providing encouragement and resources.
- Clients are helped to make a successful transition back into the community with resources including:

★ Food Resources Transportation Assistance Clothing Assistance


★ Hygiene Kits Referrals for Job Placement and Training
