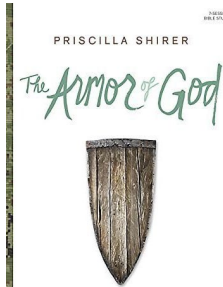

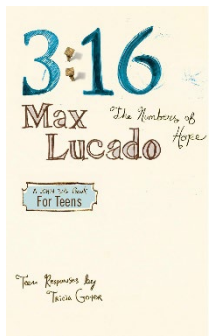
Join us this Spring as we grow together in faith through Bible study and discipleship. There is something for everyone—no matter where you are in your faith journey.

His battle plan depends on catching you unaware and unarmed. If you are tired of being pushed around and caught with your guard down, this study is for you. The Enemy always fails when he meets a woman dressed for the occasion. 3:16: The Numbers of Hope for Teens – Facilitator: Minister Michelle Redd-Latimer

3:16: The Numbers of Hope by Max Lucado is a five-session Bible study that helps teens discover the power of one simple verse—John 3:16—and what it means for their everyday lives. Through honest stories, prayers, and reflections from real teens, this study connects faith to real struggles, questions, and hopes. In each session, students explore how much God truly loves them, why Jesus matters, and how their faith can give them confidence, purpose, and direction. Known as the “Hope Diamond” of Scripture, John 3:16 reminds teens that no matter what they are facing, they are seen, valued, and deeply loved by God. Each session includes discussion questions that encourage students to think, share, and apply God's truth to their own lives. This study is perfect for teens who are new to the Bible, growing in their faith, or looking for hope and encouragement as they navigate school, relationships, and life's challenges. **Groups will meet on Sundays from 1:30pm – 3:00pm, beginning April 12, 2026.** To register:
